Aircraft equipped with Executive First Suites - Restrictions

All Executive First Suites (Boeing 777, Boeing 767 XM, Airbus A330) are equipped with inflatable seat belts. These belts are installed to protect occupants from possible head injury in the event of severe impact (i.e. impact against the Executive First Suite structure).

Attention! The following customers must not occupy the Executive First Suites:

- Children and infants using a child restraint device

Customers who are not self-reliant and are severely physically disabled (paraplegic or quadriplegic) so as to require an attendant to assist in getting in and out of a seat usually cannot be accommodated in our Executive First Suite. Exceptionally, on a case-by-case basis, authorization can be obtained from the MEDA Desk if, on fact based evidence, it determines that the attendant accompanying the non self-reliant customer is physically capable of taking full responsibility for transferring the customer in and out of the Suite (refer to [Attendant-Safety Assistant Travel Policy and Procedures](#)).
